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The beloved home of the students, a place where we can feel comfortable and happy to be in, the school of our dear fathers and mothers, it is Prince Hamzah School! This school might seem like any other school but it's actually the story of a group of women who spent countless hours thinking of establishing a school. Prince Hamzah School is considered to be the very first and the only Circassian school in Jordan and in the Middle East. It is a non-profit educational institution where the fees are affordable. The idea of constructing a school belonged to the minds of five hardworking women- Badee'a Qoursha, Jehan Shoqum, Lara Al-Khateeb, Wedad Safar, and Nazmea Abaza, with the support of Mr. Ahmad Tarawneh.



Prince Hamzah School was built by the administrative committee of the women branch of the Circassian association through charity work with the help and support of the Circassian volunteers. It began in 1974 in a rented building for kindergarten that was located in Abdoun where it was called "The Circassian Charitable Association". It was more of a nursery in a small apartment than a school in a large building. Some of our parents still remember how they finished the kindergarten and spent their first three elementary grades there. More and more children started enrolling in the small kindergarten. It wasn't a bad thing at first but the more and more children enrolled, the more and more the apartment

seemed smaller and smaller and didn't fit all of them. So the founders thought that they should transfer to another larger place. They got help from Ahmad Al Tarawneh which asked the king to give them a land to build the school on. After that, in 1979 King Al Hussain Bin Talal (May his soul rest in peace) donated a piece of land in Thuhair to build a new school. From that stage, the first building of our school was built, and Prince Hamzah School started to grow. It began with a very small number of students and then year by year this number escalated. The school was under the patronage and care of her majesty Princess Alia. Our beloved school is named after a great person- Prince Hamzah Bin Hussein. On July 12, 1980 Princess Nour Al Hussien named it Prince Hamzah School, when she visited it under the name of her son, and since then, Prince Hamzah takes care of our school.





As the years passed, that one PHS building got larger and larger. The same goes for the students that our school taught. And it was the right time to build another building and to expand our small school again. In the scholastic year 1984/1985 the second building was built. It was one floor but they were working on the second floor and a basement. They built a tunnel that connected the first building to the second one, not allowing the drops of rain wetting students in winter. PHS students spent several years of their education there, having the most memorable moments of their lives. The second floor and basement were finished in 1999. The grades from fourth to tenth were there. The same old tunnel was still there acting like a knight in shining armor during winter, protecting PHS students. In 2000 the big sandy yard was turned into an asphalt yard.





In 2007 the third building was built. It was exciting but they had to take down the tunnel. The third building consisted of the principal's office and the classrooms for the juniors and seniors. Later on, a half floor on the second building's roof was built and now we have a construction site to build the fourth building. It is quite breathtaking, watching our beloved school grow and flourish over the years.

Prince Hamzah School isn't just a school for us to learn in, it is a place for us to preserve our Circassian roots by learning our language and traditions as we grow up. The school never stopped preserving to have the best teaching staff. They've always chosen the best candidates that applied for the job. That's why we receive the best education and the most wonderful environment for us to grow up as people learning skills and lessons that would mold us to become better and more influential people in our society.

The first PHS graduation was in 1987 and it consisted of 12 students. Some of them are our parents. They were the first PHS students. We're proud of them! Watching the first graduates dressed in the Circassian traditional costumes was one of the things that made people wow! As if they have seen princes and princesses. It was just natural for many Adiga people to enroll their children in the same school to let them graduate in the Circassian traditional costumes. PHS graduates are always dressed in Circassian clothing, and Prince Hamzah graduates and congratulates them.



The members of the womens' charity in 1983 were Nabeeha Al Hasan, Soad Tash, Montaha Barto, Fathia Ghokbash, Lara Al- Khateeb, Badee'a Qardan, Jehan Shoqum, Wedad Khalifa, Nathmia Al Tarawneh, and Janet Merza. The first Circassian language teacher was Jawdat Khateeb. The library was opened at the beginning of the 1980s. The school anthem was composed by the poet Haidar Morad. The principals of PHS over the years were Ms. Huda Abida, Ms. Nadia Harbi, and Ms. Norma Batt.

The current General Manager of our school is highly respected Miss Sirsa Sholakh.







Year after year and day after day everything changes. Price Hamza School has changed to the best over the years, decade by decade. PHS is always under development. Ten years ago, there were less numbers of teachers and students in the school. Also, some teachers and students have come and left. The second department includes the grades from first to tenth. The last one is the high school department. In addition, there are other facilities. For example, our school has a library where we can read and borrow good books. It has a big

number of books that talk about different topics, cultures, and sciences. Furthermore, PHS has four computer labs and one science lab.

People say that a school is their second home. But to many of us, PHS is our mother home. PHS is not an ordinary school. It is our precious school. It is where our friends are like our siblings and our teachers are like our parents. It is where we can find our best friends who are like stars shining in the sky. Prince Hamzah School is our home. We spend most of our daytime there. To be more specific, we spend quarter of our life, quarter of our age, and three quarters of our memories there. The knowledge we have gained there is like a light in our lives. All of this is only because of our wonderful administration and teachers. The flowers of the school that always treat us as their own sons and daughters. Every single teacher has a special place in our hearts. What makes it even more unique is the teacher- student relationship. PHS really puts a lot of emphasis on this aspect.
